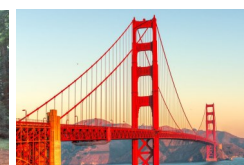
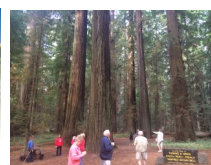
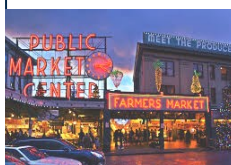

Thurs., Sept. 3: Miles City, MT We depart this morning for the Pacific Northwest on a tour that is full of beautiful scenery, exploring magnificent mountains, forests, and the coasts of British Columbia, Washington, Oregon and California. As we head west today we will travel to the Big Sky Country of Montana, staying in **Miles City, MT**.

Fri., Sept. 4: Wallace, ID (B, D) This morning we continue across Montana; passing through Billings, Bozeman, and Missoula, and into Idaho. We will overnight in **Wallace, ID**, a silver mine town. **Meal** included tonight.

Sat., Sept. 5: Leavenworth, WA (B) We will enjoy some of the natural beauty of **Lake Coeur d'Alene**, one of the five most beautiful lakes in the World. Crossing the border to Washington, we will soon be in **Spokane, WA**. Continuing on, we find ourselves in the midst of the beautiful **Cascade Mountain Range** of Washington. We will make a stop in **Wenatchee, WA**, then travel on to the Bavarian Alpine village of **Leavenworth, WA**. We will enjoy spending the night in this village. The Leavenworth area got its first homesteaders in 1885 when a handful of people settled in the Icicle Flats. The settlement was called Icicle. It became incorporated as Leavenworth in 1906, then in 1964 was developed into a Bavarian theme town.

Sun., Sept. 6: Seattle, WA (B, L) We cross over the **Cascade Mountain Range** and journey along the Skykomish River to **Seattle, WA**. We will arrive around noon and then spend time at **Seattle Waterfront** for an **included lunch** and shopping. We will also stop at the **Pike's Place Market**. Later we will visit the **Space Needle**, the site of the Seattle World's Fair that towers 605 feet above the city. You will be amazed with the beautiful views of Puget Sound, the Cascade and Olympic Mountains, and possibly Mount Rainier from the Needle.

Mon., Sept. 7: Vancouver, BC (B) A **local guide** will join us this morning for a **city tour of Seattle**. Seattle is known as the "Emerald City" and is surrounded by water and mountains. After the city tour we'll make a lunch stop before going to Mukilteo, WA. Here we'll visit the **Boeing Future of Flight Museum** for a **90-minute tour** including facts about Boeing and the planes that bear its name. You will view dreamliners on the assembly line before they take to the sky. We then travel northward on Hwy 5, crossing into Canada, on our way to **Vancouver**. Spend a relaxing night here in **Vancouver, BC, area**. (need Passport/Passcard today) Vancouver, a bustling west coast seaport in British Columbia, is among Canada's densest, most ethnically diverse cities. It was the host city for the 2010 Olympic Winter games.

Tues., Sept. 8: Victoria, BC (B, D) This morning a **local guide** will join us for a **tour around Vancouver**, through **Stanley Park, Queen Elizabeth Park, downtown Chinatown, Gastown**, and much more. Later, we travel by **ferry** to Swartz Bay in Sidney, BC, on Vancouver Island. Then reboard the bus and go to **Victoria, BC**. We will spend **two nights here in Victoria**, British Columbia's beautiful and charming

capital city, which is situated on the southeast tip of Vancouver Island. It is a major port with two harbors and a distinct English flavor. **Dinner** is included tonight.

Wed., Sept. 9: Victoria, BC (B) This morning a **local guide** will join us for a **city tour of Victoria** while we explore the area, which began as an outpost for Hudson Bay Co., in 1843. We will view the **Parliament Buildings, Christ Church Cathedral, Inner Harbor**, and other historical sights. Later we will go to **Butchart Gardens**. The 55 acres of gardens feature different styles of landscapes, masterfully displayed with thousands of flowers in various garden settings. Stroll along pathways through their wonderfully landscaped gardens. As we return to the city you will have time to visit the Empress Hotel, and the many shops and restaurants along the **Inner Harbor**.

Thurs., Sept. 10: Chehalis, WA (B, D) Passports or Passcards are needed this morning as we board the **ferry taking us to Port Angeles, WA**. This is about a 2-hour ride. Then continue to **Chehalis, WA**, where we will stay for the night. **Dinner** is included this evening.

Fri., Sept. 11: Bandon, OR (B) Our day starts with a visit to the magnificent and memorable **Multnomah Falls**. Walk to the base of the falls, where water cascades from its 611-foot drop year round. Sightseeing continues today as we travel south to **Portland, OR**. From Portland we will cut over to Scenic Hwy 101, following the Pacific coastline to **Bandon, OR**. Take in the views of **Old Town's waterfront** and spend some time shopping and exploring at the **Artists' Colony**. Our lodging will be in **Bandon, OR**.

Sat., Sept. 12: Eureka, CA (B, D) Continuing south we will travel through the **Redwoods National Park**, the "Avenue of Giants," enjoying the majestic Redwoods. Included will be a stop at the **Trees of Mystery**. Here, in nature's showcase, are some of the largest living specimens growing in fantastic and mysterious forms. This evening **dinner** will be included. Our lodging is in nearby **Eureka, CA**.

Sun., Sept. 13: San Francisco, CA (B) A gorgeous drive awaits us today as we travel through the wine country of **Sonoma Valley**, where we will have a **tour and wine tasting at Cline Cellars**. From here we will continue on to **San Francisco, CA, crossing the Golden Gate Bridge, for a two-night stay at the Holiday Inn Express**, near Fisherman's Wharf and Pier 39. San Francisco, located in northern California, is a hilly city (more than 50), on the tip of a peninsula, surrounded by the Pacific Ocean and San Francisco Bay. It is home to a little bit of everything. The California Gold Rush of 1849 brought rapid growth, making it the largest city on the west coast at that time. Some nicknames are "the City By The Bay," "Fog City," "San Fran," and more, with tourism being the top industry.

Mon., Sept. 14: San Francisco, CA (B) We will enjoy a **city tour of San Francisco** this morning, seeing all of the sights, and hearing the history and insights on the lifestyles of this area. Plus we will drive through **Chinatown** and see the lovely **Golden Gate Park**. A San Francisco **Harbor cruise** is included this afternoon with amazing views of the Golden Gate Bridge and Alcatraz Island. Later on own take a cable car ride, shop and explore the area, enjoy Pier 39, and great restaurants in the area.

Tues., Sept. 15: Flight to Minneapolis Today we depart from **San Francisco** on our **flight** home to **Minneapolis, MN**, reminiscing of our exciting tour we have enjoyed these last few days, and of the new friends we have met. Here we will be met by a motorcoach and then transferred to our drop off points, arriving home this evening. Thank you for traveling with **Utopia Tours**.
